The book and handouts are provided. Medication passes are **NOT** included and students must perform **3** med passes with an **RN**, **ON THEIR OWN** at their assisted living facility

Currently, Corey is providing Quality Assurance in 18 residential care facilities. He has instructed many various classes.

The Mental Health Support Specialist (MHSS) training meets one of the requirements for Mental Health Rehabilitation Technician (MHRT I) certification and prepares individuals to provide daily living support and residential services to individuals with mental illness. The MHSS Class is five days, 8:30-4pm. This training explores the role of the mental health support specialist by covering some of the following key topics understanding mental health and mental illness, health and recovery, trauma, communication, confidentiality, Documentation, Health and safety, Diversity. values, cultural competence, Maine mental health system and being part of the community. #### FOR ALL COURSES:

Participants are asked to dress comfortably, arrive promptly, and come prepared with a pen and highlighter. \* **All course dates subject to change.** Members of the Maine Training Collaborative will receive a discounted rate. Linda Reed, RN has had experience working with the aging population as well as working with individuals with intellectual disabilities and mental health diagnoses for over 30 years. She has taught CRMA and recert courses as well as consulted for assisted living facilities for over 25 years.

## For CRMA Recertification:

**CRMA's** must bring a copy of their current CRMA certificate and should review their abbreviations, state regulations, procedures and practice taking vital signs prior to attending the re-certification class.

Attendees should already possess the knowledge base necessary to pass the exam with the required grade of 80%.

Any attendee who cannot pass all the requirements for re-certification must re-take the 40-hour CRMA course.

## **Requirements for re-certification:**

- Transcription exercise including MAR with 100% accuracy in a single try.
- Mock med pass, including vital signs with 100% accuracy in two tries or less.
- Any written portion of clinical checklist that was not covered in two above statements.
- Final closed book exam.
